Vicarious trauma refers to the detrimental effects of work roles that involve exposure to traumatic information either through responding when traumatic events have occurred or working with people who have experienced traumatic events. It is now clear that supervisors and managers in Australian workplaces must take steps to effectively manager vicarious trauma. Effective management of vicarious trauma is both achievable and cost effective.
